Apply over a similar paint color for a bold, opaque metallic finish, or wipe on a thin coat for a subtle, shimmery look. The thick, gel-like consistency makes it easy to apply with a brush, sponge, or even a rag.

Clean Up: Clean rim of container after each use. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.

APPLICATION

After your final paint coat has dried for at least 12 hours, apply a small amount of Metallic Cream in accent areas for a bit of glam, or all over your piece by using a brush, sponge or lint-free cloth.

To create an opaque metallic finish, apply Metallic Cream over top of a similar paint color.
