DESCRIPTION

Country Chic's Clear Coat is an easy-to-use, environmentally-friendly protective sealant designed for use on painted furniture. The finish is crystal clear and provides excellent protection for all your projects.

PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS

Coverage: 120+ sq. ft/quart

VOCs: < 1 grams/liter

PH: 8.5 - 9.5

Clean Up: Clean rim of container after each use. Brushes can be cleaned with warm, soapy water.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area. Keep from freezing. Keep away from heat sources. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store in a well ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Keep out of reach of children. Do not take internally.

Shelf Life: At least one year after opening in a well sealed container.

Disposal: Dispose of contents/container in accordance with paint collection facility's instructions.

First Aid: In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water as a precaution. Wash skin with soap and water. If ingested, call physician or the Poison Control Centre.

APPLICATION

Before you apply Clear Coat, make sure the final coat of paint has dried for at least 24 hours and that your project is clean, dust-free and dry. Stir Clear Coat well before and during use.

Do NOT shake the jar. Shaking will incorporate bubbles that you don't want to appear on the finish of your piece.

Apply an even coat of Clear Coat with a painting sponge or foam brush. Allow to dry completely; approximately 1 hour. Apply two to three additional coats based on the level of protection required. Allow for 1 hour dry time between each coat.

Let dry 24 hours before using the surface. Allow a week of cure time to develop maximum scratch and moisture resistance.

Please note: NO wax should be used underneath Clear Coat. Not intended for kitchen counters.
